

## **Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) Fee Structure**

**Annual Total Fee: ₹28,500**

### **1. Tuition Fee**

The tuition fee covers the core academic expenses, including classroom teaching, faculty resources, and access to academic facilities.

- **Amount: ₹18,000 per year**

### **2. Library Fee**

This fee grants students access to the library's vast collection of textbooks, journals, reference materials, and digital resources. It also covers the maintenance of the library and its services, such as the reading rooms and study spaces.

- **Amount: ₹2,000 per year**

### **3. Laboratory and Resource Fee**

The laboratory and resource fee is charged for the use of the psychology lab, language lab, science and math labs, and the ICT (computer) lab. This includes maintenance of equipment and consumables used during practical sessions.

- **Amount: ₹2,500 per year**

### **4. Sports and Extracurricular Activities Fee**

This fee supports the maintenance of sports facilities, the organization of inter-collegiate competitions, and the promotion of physical and extracurricular activities, such as yoga, gym, and indoor/outdoor games.

- **Amount: ₹1,500 per year**

### **5. Examination Fee**

The examination fee covers the expenses related to internal assessments, university examinations, grading, and issuing of mark sheets and certificates.

- **Amount: ₹2,000 per year**

### **6. Development Fee**

The development fee is used to fund infrastructural improvements, technological upgrades, and campus development initiatives to enhance the learning environment for students.

- **Amount: ₹1,500 per year**

### **7. Identity Card and Miscellaneous Charges**

This covers the cost of issuing identity cards, attendance registers, and general administrative services provided throughout the academic year.

- **Amount: ₹500 per year**

### **8. Caution Deposit (Refundable)**

A refundable caution deposit is collected at the time of admission. This deposit covers potential damage or loss of library books, lab equipment, or other college property. It is returned upon completion of the course, provided no dues are outstanding.

- **Amount: ₹500 (one-time payment)**
